BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

December 18, 2017

A meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Nebraska was held on the 18th day of December, 2017 at the Butler County Courthouse in David City, Nebraska at 9:00 a.m.

Present were the following: David W. Mach, Tony Krafka, Kevin Slama, Max Birkel, Scott Steager, Greg Janak, and David Potter.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof, by Publication, a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Proof of Publication attached to the minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to all members of the board of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Chairman called the meeting to order, and announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room.

The Chairman declared that the minutes from the previous meeting shall stand approved as presented.

Permit to Construct Utilities on County Right-of-Way Request

A permit to construct utilities on county right-of-way was submitted by Butler County Landfill to install a treated storm water discharge 12" CMP pipe between Sections 13 and 24, Township 15 North, Range 3 East. Moved by Janak, seconded by Slama to approve the permit as presented. Upon roll call vote the following voted aye: Janak, Krafka, Slama, Potter, and Birkel. The following voted nay: Steager and Mach. Motion carried.

Sign Installation in Alexis Township

Jim Rerucha, Highway Superintendent and Scott Steager, Emergency Manager drove roads north of 44 Road in Alexis Township, and determined that additional signage needs to be placed in certain areas. Particularly the area of 44 ½ Road, between C Road and D Road. Moved by Krafka, seconded by Steager to approve the installation of the signage as presented. Upon roll call vote the following voted aye: Krafka, Steager, Janak, Birkel, Potter, Slama, and Mach. The following voted nay: None. Motion carried.

Beaver Lane/Wilderness Lake 1st Subdivision

Wilderness Lake 1st Subdivision located in Sections 3 and 10, Township 16 North, Range 1 East has a road platted within the subdivision named Beaver Lane. The question is whether or not the road is for public use. The County Attorney will review the documents and report to the board at a later date.

Revision of Snow Removal Plowing Policies/Guidelines

The Highway Superintendent explained revisions to the Snow Plowing Policies/Guidelines that was presented at the November 20, 2017 meeting.

The County Attorney also, referred to a section in the policy that needed to be removed.

Following discussion, the Highway Superintendent will make the necessary changes to the policy.

Update on Building Bridges for Private Property Access

At the December 4, 2017 board meeting, discussion was held regarding the building of bridges for private property access, and the possible need for a policy that addresses this issue. The Highway Superintendent was to check with other counties for policies they have adopted. He was unable to find a policy in place in another county. The State of Nebraska Bridge Division was contacted, and they are reviewing the issue.

Restriction on New Driveways Installed/Fee for Installation of Driveways

Discussion was held with the Highway Superintendent regarding the installation of new driveways, and the possibility of imposing a fee. The County has a Driveway and Culvert Installation Policy currently in place. It was discussed that revision could be made to that policy to include any restrictions and/or fees.

Ulysses Township

Mark Stara, Ulysses Township Board member appeared before the board to discuss the amount paid to Butler County as per the terms of the Interlocal Agreement for Road Maintenance. The township levies an amount for a General Fund and a Library Fund. As per the terms of the Interlocal Agreement, the amount that was levied for the Library Fund was not taken into consideration.

The County Board is requesting that the Highway Superintendent do an analysis of the costs to maintain the roads in Ulysses Township. Also, they want an analysis of the costs for maintaining the roads in each of the townships that have an Interlocal Agreement for Road Maintenance with the County.

This information will be reviewed by the Road and Bridge committee.

At 10:07 a.m., Chairman Mach announced that the Board would take a short recess.

At 10:13 a.m., Chairman Mach announced that the Board would reconvene.

Senior Center Garage Project

Al Hottovy, Leo A Daly Company appeared before the board to give an update of the garage project. He stated that the project is moving along as scheduled. Supervisor Steager and Supervisor Janak questioned the sidewalk on the south side of the building. Mr. Hottovy said that he will check on the sidewalk to make sure it is ADA compliant.

Discussion followed on the fee for Task 5 and Task 6 of the agreement between Butler County and Leo A Daly Company. Moved by Potter, seconded by Steager to pay an hourly rate, not to exceed \$6,000.00; subject to the task order verbage being changed. Upon roll call vote the following voted aye: Potter, Birkel, Janak, Steager, Krafka, Slama, and Mach. The following voted nay: None. Motion carried.

This matter is tabled till the next meeting of the County Board.

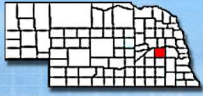

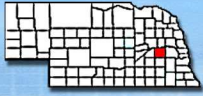
