BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

October 30, 2018

A special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Nebraska was held on the 30th day of October, 2018 at the Butler County Courthouse in David City, Nebraska at 12:00 noon.
